### **Introduction:**

*In urban economy water can be a precious resource serving not only drinking and sanitary needs of inhabitants, but also enhancing cities' image and adding to their recreational and residential attractiveness. If mismanaged, it can be however a significant cost to local taxpayers and even a threat to their property, health or lives. Local policies with this regard and quality of their implementation will determine what this gift of the nature will constitute for urban population.*

*An interdisciplinary group of experts: geographers, planners, architects, sociologists, hydrologists, but also the representatives of local actors from Central and Eastern*

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*European countries will exchange experiences and share their knowledge on various aspects of water use in urban areas with an aim to establish international and interregional cooperation.*

### **Objectives of the event:**

#### Learning Objectives:

1. Participants will explore regional trends and applicable best practices in urban water and waterfront areas management cross Central and Eastern European Municipalities.
2. Participants will apply UNITAR self-assessment tools to compare and rate policies for urban water and waterfront areas management.
3. Participants will explore financing and practical integration of selected practices taking into consideration their specific situation.

#### Content and Structure:

Module 1: Water and Urban Landscape: a Value or a Threat?

Module 2: Waterfront Planning and Revitalizing

Module 3: Best Practices in Regional Water and Waterfront Areas Management

Module 4: Applying Self-Assessment and Comparing Regional Water and Waterfront Areas Management Models

Module 5: Developing Action Plans for City-to-City Cooperation and Integration of Water and Waterfront Areas Management Practices

### **Format and organization :**

- 1-day conference will be accompanied by 2-day workshop in the spirit of exchange of experience and best practice including: an application of the “City-Share” methodology which consists of various processes of self-assessment, distillation and transmission of experiences and good practices. It is also composed of several tools which provide a common framework for the evaluation of experiences made by the participating cities and offer a common language for the exchange and assimilation of the experiences, as well as a roadmap for action and progress.
- classroom lectures, both by local and international resource persons (senior and experienced officials from relevant institutions, international experts, practitioners from the private sector and other local partners).
- different projects' location visits/field visits.
- presentation of case studies and experiences by participants.

### **Target group:**

- circa 25 participants from Central and Eastern Europe including: Iregional mayors, municipal technical staff, relevant private sector representatives, topical experts, and national and regional water authorities
- not more than 2 people from one institution (can be the same city) - at least one of them should have good working knowledge of English language.

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### **Conditions of participation:**

- language: the entire workshop will be conducted in English.
- place and date: Płock (Poland), 22<sup>nd</sup> - 24<sup>th</sup> March 2011 (arrival is expected on 21<sup>st</sup> and departure on 25<sup>th</sup> of March 2011).

### **Travel arrangement:**

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- Participants attending the training course are expected to arrive in Płock on 21<sup>st</sup> of March and to depart on 25<sup>th</sup> of March 2011.
- Participants who have provided their travel details in advance will be met by the CIFAL Płock's staff upon their arrival at Warsaw airport or railway/bus station. Please be on the look-out for our staff holding a CIFAL Płock sign. They will subsequently take you to the hotel and will take participants back to Warsaw airport or railway/bus station on day of departure, if travel details were provided at the soonest possible time.

#### **Cost:**

The organizers will cover the cost of your accommodation, meals, training materials and local transportation cost (from and to Warsaw) for the duration of the training course; other charges (bar, telephone calls etc.) will have to be covered by the participant. The first meal covered is the dinner on 21<sup>st</sup> of March at the hotel and the last meal is breakfast on 25<sup>th</sup> of March 2011.

#### **Working language**

English is the official language of the training course.

#### **Foreign exchange:**

The currency of Poland is zloty (PLN). The current exchange rate is approximately 1 USD = 3,0 PLN, 1 EUR = 4,0 PLN

#### **Weather:**

The temperature in Płock is expected to be between 5 and 15 degrees Celsius, but March is a period with a very variable weather, there may be significant deviation from this.

#### **Food arrangement:**

Vegetarian meals will be available per requests.

#### **Others:**

Please note that the organizers will assume no responsibility for the following expenditures: the cost of travel from home country to Warsaw

- all expenses in the home country incidental to travel abroad, including expenditure for visa, medical examination, inoculations and other such miscellaneous items as well as internal travel to and from airport of arrival and departure in the home country;
- salary and related allowances for the participants during the period of the training course;
